Self-cleaning; no deadheading necessary.

Exposure: Full sun

Height: 16-24"

Spacing: 18-24"

Hardy Temp: 30°F (-1°C)

Uses:

Use in large combinations and landscapes.

Features:

Vista is a perfect landscape plant because of its vigor and mounding growth habit. It blooms all season and has better heat and humidity tolerance than any other plant on the market, as evidenced by its performance in Southern trials. Vista averages 6 to 8 weeks longer than generic Petunias in the landscape.

Growing Tips for SUPERTUNIA®

- Requires high light in production.
- Needs 250+ ppm fertilizer. Watch pH and EC levels.
- Mini Strawberry Pink Veined and Mini Rose Veined are more sensitive to cold. Keep above 50° F.
- Day-length neutral varieties need less PGRs. Cold temperatures also control growth.
- Yellow growth tips often indicate an iron shortage in response to high pH.

Additional Culture Information for SUPERTUNIA®

pH/EC: 5.5 - 5.8 / 1.0 - 2.0
 Growing Temperature: 65-72°/55-65°
 Holding Temperature: 40-50° outdoors
 Water Requirements: Moderate to Moist
 Planting and Timing: Early Spring through Fall Finish.
 Standard Plants Per Pot.
 Finish Times in Weeks: For 4-5", 4-6; for 6"/gallon, 5-7;
 for 8", 7-9; for 10-12", 10-12
 Spring Outdoor Finish: First to go outside

Notes:

For pots 6" and smaller, pinch at transplanting only.
 For hanging baskets and pots larger than 6", soft pinch at planting and trim around pot just prior to hanging.
 10-15 ppm Sumagic® spray or 1-3 ppm Bonzi® drench are effective at controlling growth. Apply as needed.
 Supertunia Minis may require higher rates of PGRs.
