


12 Fall Container-Garden Recipes

Make a statement to your entrance with a well-placed container or two. For classic gardens, it's tough to beat an urn filled with flowers such as the one shown here.


A. Purple Fountaingrass (*Pennisetum* 'Burgundy Giant') -- 1


A. Euphorbia amygdaloides 'Efanthia' -- 1

Grow Glorious Grasses

Grasses are a no-brainer for fall gardens. Keep them in mind for your container plantings, too. Most grasses look great in pots. Here, purple fountaingrass and blue fescue create a lovely contrast for pink mums and yellow strawflower.

A. Blue fescue (*Festuca glauca*) -- 1

B: Pink mum (Chrysanthemum 'Cecilia') -- 2

C. Strawflower (*Bracteantha* 'Sundaze Golden Yellow') -- 1
